ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE IN 21ST CENTURY

Concept Note:

It is generally agreed that: “Environmental Justice is the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, colour, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and politics. It will be achieved when everyone enjoys the same degree of protection from environmental and health hazards and equal access to the decision-making process to have a healthy environment, in which we live, learn and work. There is a pressing need to engage with uneasy questions that stare at us provoking discomfort as to what hold us in times to come. The rapid proliferation of law, both at national as well as international level has been a welcome development. However, a lot remains to be desired in terms of understanding the nuances the niceties of justice being done to those who are at the receiving ends of activities that are not in consonance with normative standards so painstakingly laid down under international covenants and municipal legislations.

2. International Law Perspective
3. Philosophical Issues
4. Legislative and Judicial Response
5. Human Rights Issues

Objectives

1. To bring a social-legal and policy clarification among other things for effective combating menace of pollution and human right violation.
2. To discuss the legal aspect of environmental protection and need for environmental law.
3. To identify and acknowledge the role of legislature and judiciary in combating Environmental law violation.
4. To look upon the moral, ethical, social and political grounds for protection of environment.
5. To analyse welfare program and role of government in environmental protection.
6. To discuss the growing challenges and need for strict environmental laws.

Submission Guidelines

1. Authors can choose any one of the above themes given.
2. Papers should be written in English.
3. Co-authorship is allowed, subject to a limit of maximum two authors per submission.
4. The text should be in Times New Roman, font size 12, spacing 1.5.
5. Bluebook style of 19th edition citation shall be followed for citation.
6. A margin of 1 inch shall be left on all sides of the paper.
7. No part of the paper should have been published earlier nor should it be under consideration for publication.
8. Any form of plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
9. Full name & Address of all the authors must be given while submitting the abstract.
10. Participants (including author and co-author) will be required to fill out the form which will be sent through email after intimation of selection of paper for publication.
11. The registration fees need to be paid latest by 15th April 2017.
12. Publication of papers submitted will be subject to the scrutiny of the publisher.
